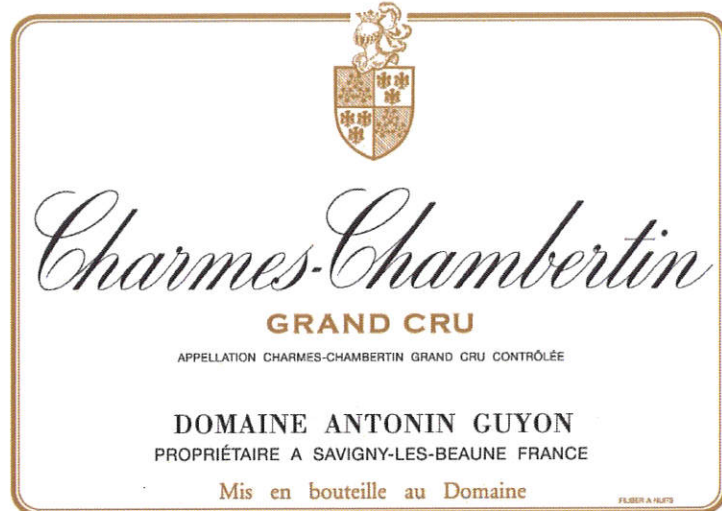

CHARMES-CHAMBERTIN Grand Cru

SITUATION

CHARMES-CHAMBERTIN Grand Cru is one of the Grand Cru located in the village of Gevrey Chambertin.

SURFACE

The Domaine GUYON wine area for CHARMES-CHAMBERTIN cover 8.65 ares (0.21 acres).

SOIL AND GRAPE VARIETY

Soil : limestone and clay.
Grape variety : Pinot Noir 100%.
Age of vines : 35 years old.

HARVEST AND VINIFICATION

Hand harvested, the grapes are then carried in small boxes and sorted out upon arrival at the winery.
Long fermentation during 15 days in wooden open vats with punching down of the cap and temperature control.

AGEING

Ageing in oak barrels (100 % new oak) and estate bottling after 18 months.

CHARACTER

Very nice ruby robe with morello cherry aromas. The wine is very rich with soft tannins and a lot of finesse. It can be kept for 15 years

SERVICE

To be served at 18°C with most of game and meat in sauce
