CORTON BRESSANDES

DOM. ANTONIN GUYON Corton Bressandes Grand Cru 2020 ★★

Covering 17.40 hectares, this is the largest of the 25 classified climats on the Corton hill. Dominique Guyon produces a Corton with a ruby robe that gently tiles on the rim of the glass and exudes refined character. The nose is subtle yet delicate, oscillating between violet and blackcurrant, with just a hint of oak. This elegant bouquet infuses a silky texture, supported by fine, tightly knit tannins that in no way diminish its charm. A precise, classy wine, perfectly harmonious, with good ageing potential. Drink: 2027–2035



SAVIGNY LES BEAUNE

DOM. ANTONIN GUYON Les Goudelettes 2020 ★★

A climat located at 350 meters altitude, known for its Chardonnays but also capable of excelling in red. This 2020 is proof, with a subtle nose of peony and wild strawberry. The fruit expresses itself vibrantly on the palate, which is broad and full from the outset, carried by sparkling freshness and gently framed by soft, melting tannins. Utterly charming, with a captivated tasting panel. Drink: 2024–2028

GEVREY CHAMBERTIN

DOM. ANTONIN GUYON La Justice 2020 ★

A cuvée regularly featured in the Guide, made from 45-year-old vines planted across nearly 2 hectares. With an intense color, it offers a generous and fleshy mouthfeel, finishing with persistent spicy notes. A well-balanced wine, fully representative of the great potential of the 2020 vintage. Drink: 2026–2033

PERNAND VERGELESSES

DOM. DOMINIQUE GUYON Les Vergelesses 2020 ★

Grapes harvested at full maturity deliver a strikingly dark color and a nose marked by notes of dried fruits and prune. Fleshy, full-bodied, heady, with well-integrated tannins, the palate retains a refreshing lift. A generous Pinot that will evolve beautifully in the cellar. Drink: 2024–2028

ALOXE-CORTON

DOM. ANTONIN GUYON Les Fournières 1^{er} Cru 2019



Les Fournières, one of the largest premier crus of the appellation, is a consistent benchmark for the estate. A relaxed nose with scents of kirsch cherries and sweet spices gives way to a rich yet tender palate, supported by already well-melted tannins. A profile that makes it instantly appealing. Drink: 2023–2027

CORTON BRESSANDES

DOM. ANTONIN GUYON Corton Bressandes Grand Cru 2019



A restrained yet refined nose where oak gracefully steps aside for red berries and mint. A lively, tangy attack leads into a supple and relaxed palate, framed by soft tannins and releasing deep nuances of cherry from a Pinot of great pedigree. A refined, generous Corton already offering great pleasure. Drink: 2024–2030
