Corton Clos du Roy 2022

93 points

A dense, powerful red, defined as much by its vivid acidity as its muscular profile. Blackcherry, blackberry, earth, iron, woody and sweet spice flavors combine as the finish tightens up. All the components are there. Best from 2029 through 2047.—B.S.

Corton-Bressandes 2022

93 points

This opulent style starts out supple before chalky tannins take hold of its cherry, blackberry, earth and mineral flavors. Muscular, solid and dry, this lingers, offering a fruit- and oak spice-filled finish. Best from 2027 through 2045.—B.S.

Volnay Clos des Chênes 2020

93 points

Delivers vibrant acidity that delineates black currant and blackberry fruit flavors, with floral, sandalwood, vanilla, and earth accents. Features dense, fine-grained tannins and a finish that stretches out, revealing echoes of fruit and spices. Best from 2026 through.—B.S.

Corton-Bressandes 2020

94 points

A polished red, with black cherry, blackberry and floral aromas and flavors matched to a refined, well-integrated structure. Features fine balance, freshness and details of mineral and spices. The lingering finish echoes the fruit. Just a little compact now, so be patient. Best from 2027 through 2045.—B.S.

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Corton-Charlemagne 2022 : 93 points

Broad and buttery, this white reveals lemon, peach, apple and baking spice flavors. Starts out wide but converges on the finish to a well-defined point of citrus and mineral notes. Offers harmony and a persistent aftertaste. Drink now through 2032.

Corton Clos du Roy 2022 : 93 points

A dense, powerful red, defined as much by its vivid acidity as its muscular profile. Black cherry, blackberry, earth, iron, woody and sweet spice flavors combine as the finish tightens up. All the components are there. Best from 2029 through 2047.

Corton-Bressandes 2022 : 93 points

This opulent style starts out supple before chalky tannins take hold of its cherry, blackberry, earth and mineral flavors. Muscular, solid and dry, this lingers, offering a fruit- and oak spice-filled finish. Best from 2027 through 2045..

Charmes-Chambertin 2022 : 92 points

Taut and framed by vibrant acidity, this red displays cherry, blackberry, violet, iron and oak spice aromas and flavors. Intense and complex, with a mineral element emerging on the lingering aftertaste. Lean and toned, showing excellent balance. Best from 2028 through 2045.

Chambolle-Musigny Les Cras 2022 : 92 points

An opulent red, featuring cherry, blackberry, black currant, violet and spice flavors. A line of dense tannins provides structure, along with fresh acidity. Showing fine harmony and length, this ends with a crisp finish. Best from 2027 through 2040.

Meursault Charmes Les Charmes Dessus 2022 : 91 points

Peach, apricot, honey and bitter flavors mingle in this creamy white. Shows oak spice and briny mineral accents as this turns more focused on the extended finish. The vivid structure keeps everything together. Drink now through 2032.

Aloxe-Corton Les Fournières 2022 : 91 points

The core of cherry and blackberry is framed with a sweet sawdust element in this supple red. Tangy, intense and balanced, with a chalky feel on the long finish. Best from 2027 through 2042.

Volnay Clos des Chênes 2022 : 91 points

Silky and sporting floral aromas and flavors, along with cherry, raspberry, spice and mineral notes, this offers a sinewy feel yet stays intense and long. Best from 2027 through 2042.

Savigny-lès-Beaune Les Goudelettes 2022 : 90 points

This juicy red delivers cherry, raspberry, floral and spice flavors, while firm, sinewy tannins lend support. Leaves a mouthwatering impression on the mint-tinged finish. Best from 2027 through 2042.

Pernand-Vergelesses White Sous Frétille 2022 : 89 points

Peach and pear flavors are shaded with coconut and lemon meringue in this plump, crisp white. More impactful up front, with the lemony, salty finish tailing off a little. Drink now through 2028.

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Corton Charlemagne Grand Cru 2020 : 94 points

Harmonious and buttery, this white features creamy lemon, peach, baking spice and sweet butter flavors. Well-balanced and integrated, this is very approachable now, yet with vibrant acidity underneath and a lingering, tangy, mineral-laced finish. Best from 2025 through 2038.

Corton Bressandes Grand Cru 2020 : 94 points

A polished red, with black cherry, blackberry and floral aromas and flavors matched to a refined, well-integrated structure. Features fine balance, freshness and details of mineral and spices. The lingering finish echoes the fruit. Just a little compact now, so be patient. Best from 2027 through 2045.

Volnay 1er Cru Clos des Chênes 2020 : 93 points

Delivers vibrant acidity that delineates black currant and blackberry fruit flavors, with floral, sandalwood, vanilla and earth accents. Features dense, fine-grained tannins and a finish that stretches out, revealing echoes of fruit and spices. Best from 2026 through 2040.

Corton Clos du Roy Grand Cru 2020 : 92 points

A ripe, spicy red marked by black cherry, kirsch, blackberry liqueur and earth, with just a hint of tomato leaf. Delivers dense tannins that come to the fore midpalate, dominating the finish with light astringency. Best from 2027 through 2039.

Chambolle Musigny Les Cras 2020 : 91 points

A rich, silky red, with smoky overtones gracing the black cherry and blackberry fruit flavors. Picks up incense and spice details as this fades elegantly on the finish. Shows fine harmony and length. Drink now through 2030.

Gevrey Chambertin La Justice 2020 : 90 points

A smooth, earth- and spice-tinged red highlighted by dark cherry and plum flavors, with the up-front fruit and supple texture giving way to a layer of powdery tannins. Reveals lingering spice and herbal notes, with spicy oak on the protracted finish. Best from 2024 through 2038.

Savigny les Beaune Les Goudelettes 2020 : 90 points

A succulent red, featuring cherry, currant, earth, spices and a hint of game. Supple and harmonious, with fine cut and a mouthwatering finish. Drink now through 2032.

Bourgogne Hautes Cotes de Nuits 2020 : 89 points

Les Dames de Vergy

Bright, exuding black cherry and blackberry fruit shaded by spices and sweet smoke. Supple and charming, this is delicious now, firming up slightly on the finish. Drink now through 2027.
