



DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON



With 47 hectares spread across 25 different climats, this family-run estate, pieced together from countless parcels, boasts a truly unique viticultural heritage, with a particularly strong presence around the hill of Corton. The wines are true to their terroirs, unadorned, sincere, and expressive. The estate is managed by Dominique Guyon and has been organically farmed, with official certification starting from the 2018 vintage.

The red wines, made from partially destemmed grapes, combine ripe fruit with fine tannins. They are faithful expressions of their respective terroirs, with a high-flying Corton Clos du Roi in 2022 and remarkable white wines.

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The red wines, made from partially destemmed grapes, combine ripe fruit with fine tannins. They are faithful expressions of their respective terroirs. In white, the Meursault Charmes Premier Cru *Les Charmes Dessus* and the Corton-Charlemagne are mouthwatering. The 2021 red wines are highly successful, displaying a density unusual for the vintage and built for cellaring.

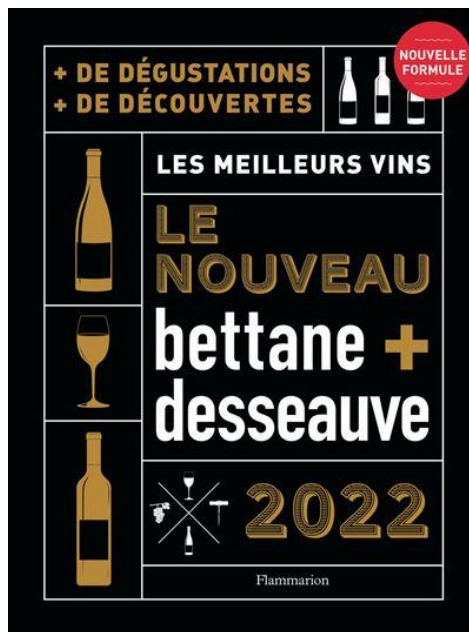
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With 47 hectares spread across 25 climats, this family estate, assembled from a mosaic of small plots, possesses a unique viticultural legacy, especially with top-tier holdings around the Corton hill. The wines remain true to their origins, crafted without artifice and full of authenticity. Under the stewardship of Dominique Guyon, the vineyard has been cultivated organically and certified since the 2018 vintage.

The red wines, made from partially destemmed grapes, offer a fine balance between ripe fruit and refined tannins. They are accurate reflections of their respective terroirs. The 2020 reds are especially successful, fully capitalizing on the strengths of the vintage. In white, both the Meursault Charmes Premier Cru *Les Charmes Dessus* and the Corton-Charlemagne are highly recommended.

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With 47 hectares across 25 climats, this family-run domaine, painstakingly assembled from numerous parcels, enjoys a remarkable viticultural heritage, particularly with prime holdings around the Corton hill. The wines are honest expressions of their origin, made without embellishment and full of sincerity. Managed by Dominique Guyon, the estate has been organically farmed and certified since the 2018 vintage.

The red wines, from partially destemmed grapes, marry ripe fruit with elegant tannins. They offer a faithful portrait of their terroirs. The 2019 reds are a great success, making the most of a high-quality vintage. Among the whites, the Corton-Charlemagne is especially impressive.

■ Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru 2019 – 95 pts

The domaine has crafted a beautiful Corton-Charlemagne. The complex bouquet blends saline, floral, and creamy aromas. The palate follows through with the same notes, enriched by the signature hazelnut nuance typical of this grand cru. The finish is elevated by a delicate saline touch that adds complexity.

■ Gevrey-Chambertin La Justice 2019 – 93 pts

This is the roundest, most charming example of La Justice we've seen in years. The warmth of the 2019 vintage left its mark on this sunny terroir near Brochon. The wine is fleshy, beautifully ripe, surprisingly voluminous, broad on the palate, and full of joy.
